Total of Best 4 Subjects + English (Excluding Environmental Studies) = Merit Index

Total of Best 4 Subjects + History (Excluding Environmental Studies) = Merit Index

Total of Best 4 Subjects + Political Science (Excluding Environmental Studies) = Merit Index
